"Video Surveillance Registration Form"

The Woodcliff Lake Police Department is committed to our partnership with business owners, as well as our residents. Many business owners and residents currently operate surveillance systems on their properties. As a crime occurs nearby, or on the property, they are not always aware that their system may have captured valuable information and/or footage that could potentially assist in solving a crime. In turn, the police are also not aware who may have this potentially vital information. This program allows police to map out businesses and residences that have active video surveillance systems, and who to contact if they needed to view it.

The Woodcliff Lake Police Department is asking business owners and residents, to voluntarily register their privately owned surveillance systems. As the police respond to a criminal incident in your neighborhood, the information and/or footage could assist in the apprehension and prosecution of those involved. The Woodcliff Lake Police simply compile a data base and map the results for crime solving situations. They do not monitor or control any registered cameras.

After registering your surveillance system, you could possibly be contacted by this agency if an incident occurs in you vicinity. Officers/Detectives would then request to view your privately owned video system. Contact would be made via telephone or email and during reasonable hours of the day.

Information provided to the Woodcliff Lake Police Department regarding your registration form and your camera system is for official police use only. Your personal information is confidential and NOT for public dissemination.
